

M&M Chocolate Cookie Mix in a Jar

Ingredients:

White flour	2/3 cup
Baking soda	¼ teaspoon
Salt	1/8 teaspoon
White sugar	½ cup
Cocoa powder	3 Tablespoons
M&Ms	1/3 cup
White chocolate chips	1/3 cup
Margarine or softened butter	¼ cup
Egg	1
Vanilla	½ teaspoon



Directions to make dry cookie mix:

1. In small bowl, combine flour, baking soda and salt. Set aside.
2. Add each dry ingredient to a 500 ml (2 cup) jar or container carefully, one layer at a time. After adding each ingredient, *gently* shake the jar to flatten out the layer. Suggested order for layers: sugar, cocoa powder, flour mixture, M&Ms, white chocolate chips. (The butter, egg and vanilla do not go into the jar.)

Directions for baking cookies:

1. Preheat oven to 350 F. Grease baking sheet or line with parchment paper
2. In large bowl, cream together butter, egg and vanilla using a large spoon, whisk, or fork. The mixture will lumpy.
3. Add contents of jar and mix together. Dough will be stiff.
4. Scoop out 1 Tablespoon of dough at a time and form into a ball. Space cookies about 2 inches apart. Flatten each ball slightly.
5. Bake 10 to 12 minutes. Cool tray on wire rack. **Makes about 12 cookies.**
