Healthy Start Outreach Worker – full time (daytime), TERM position – maternity leave

Healthy Start seeks a caring and resourceful person for its prenatal and postnatal outreach community work for a maternity leave, term position. Outreach workers facilitate drop-in group sessions from multiple locations throughout Winnipeg. The program reaches out to pregnant and parenting families who may live on low incomes or experience isolation.

Outreach workers who share similar life experiences to the participants are an essential element of the Healthy Start program. Responsibilities include: connecting with families, establishing trusting and supportive relationships, helping families make connections in their community, paperwork, working collaboratively with a team to plan and facilitate community drop-in educational groups.

We seek someone who has:

- a reliable car to be used every day and valid driver’s license
- understanding, based on experience, of pregnancy and parenting with other life stressors
- ability to connect in a non-judgmental and empathetic way with families living in poverty or isolation
- high school diploma, post-secondary education an asset
- experience using a computer, emails, participating in virtual meetings
- related employment or volunteer experience is essential
- experience with cultural, immigrant and Indigenous issues is an asset
- ability to work in a job where no two days are the same, involves complex issues, in groups and with individuals
- exceptional listening skills and ability to be flexible and calm
- ability to communicate well, both verbally and in writing
- experience facilitating/presenting information in a group setting
- additional language an asset
- willingness to complete a satisfactory criminal record and child abuse registry checks
- ability to meet the physical demands of the position (lifting and carrying are required daily)

Salary is \$32,760 annually (approximately \$18/hr), Daytime hours, 5 days per week.
